The YMCA of Honolulu recently celebrated its 150th anniversary with a gala fundraiser at the Ko'olau Ballrooms in Kaneohe. Although it is the oldest and largest YMCA in the state it is not the only association in Hawai'i. We are fortunate to also have YMCAs on three neighbor islands with the oldest being the Waiakea YMCA in Hilo. This Y owes its existence to the efforts of the Hilo Y Service Club who raised the original funds to build the branch in the 1930's and remains an active supporter. On the Garden Island the YMCA of Kaua'i serves the needs of its community both directly and through the efforts of the East Kaua'i Y Service Club that has traditionally organized activities and fundraising on behalf of the Y.
